

### Phonics - Lesson 1

Today we are learning the spelling rule that when the s sound comes before an 'e', 'i' or 'y' it is spelt with a c.

Do you think it should be spelt with a s or a c? All the words have a c where the s sound is heard.



















This week we will be imagining what it would be like to be one of Three Little Wolves. Did they have a good day or a bad day ?

Today you will need to use your imagination and also think about how the Big Bad Pig was feeling and why he was trying to get into all of the houses The Three Little Wolves had built.


### Task - Drama role play

Remember to listen to others, take turns and ask and answer questions using a clear and loud voice.






Today we are looking at words when the s sound comes before an 'e', 'i' or 'y' it is spelt with a c.

Look carefully to see whether the following letter is an 'e', 'i' or 'y'.





### Phonics - Lesson 4

In today's lesson you will be doing crosswords. You will need to find the word that goes with each picture.


The first crossword is when the s sound is spelt with a c.

Some of the pictures in this crossword are words that have an 'e', 'i' or 'y' in them so the s sound is spelt with a c.

There are also some words that do not have an 'e', 'i' or 'y' in them so the s sound is spelt with an s.




Crossword /s/ 'c' and 's'


