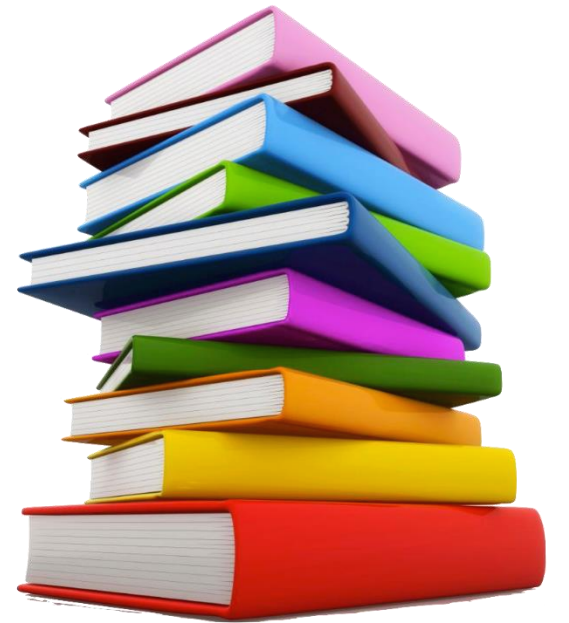

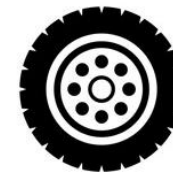


# English - Lesson 1

Can your sleigh move in a straight line?

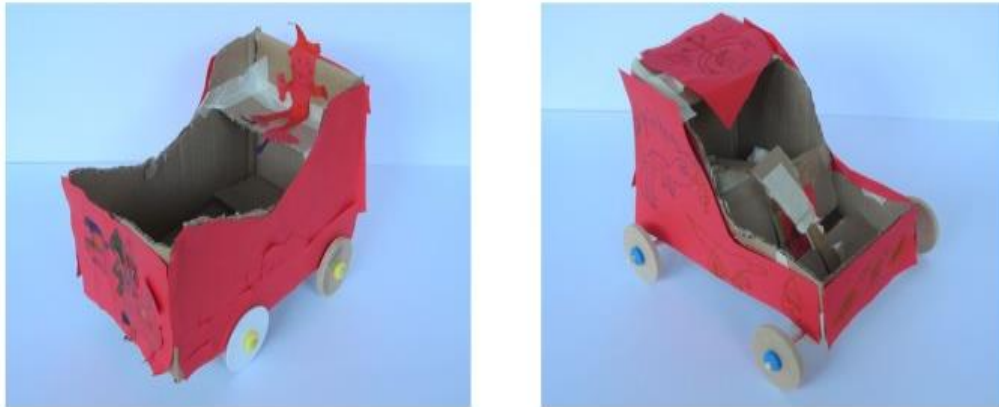
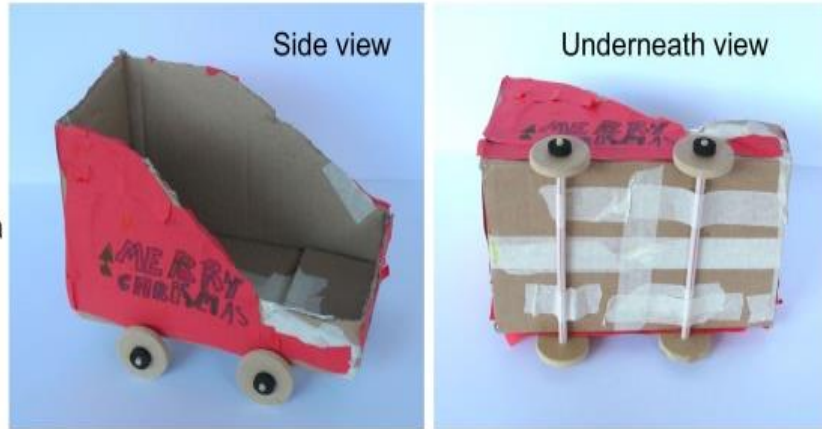
Do the wheels roll?

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Are there any changes you made to your design ?

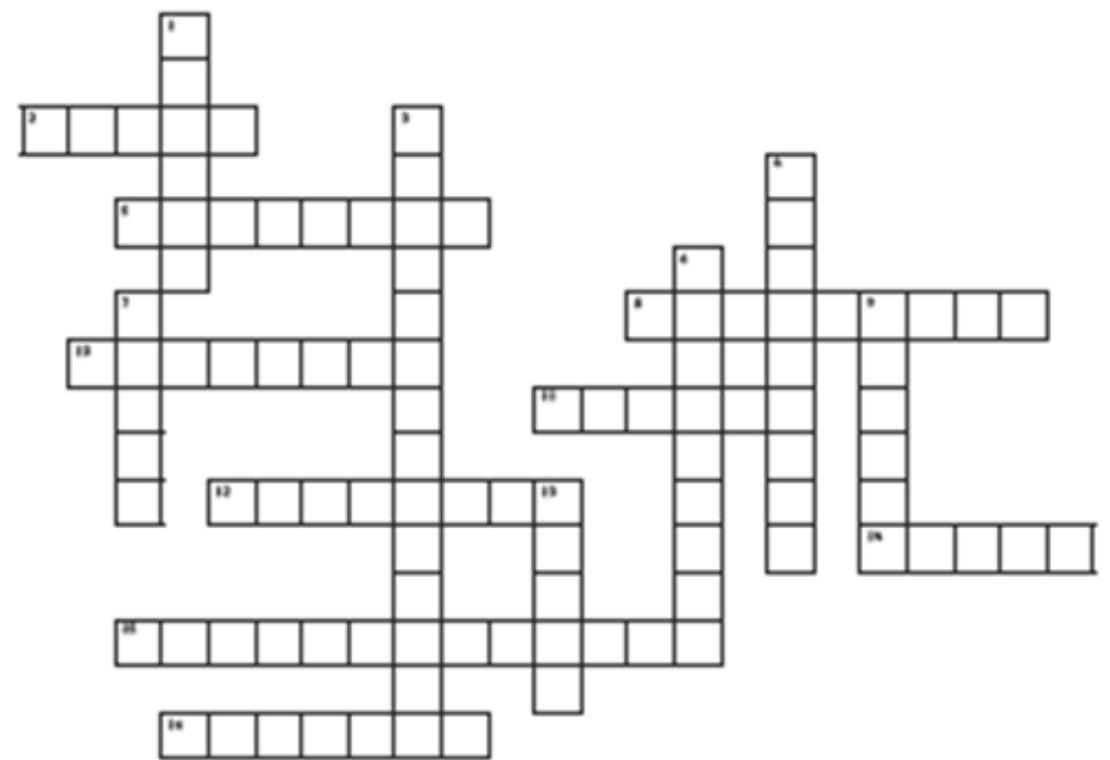
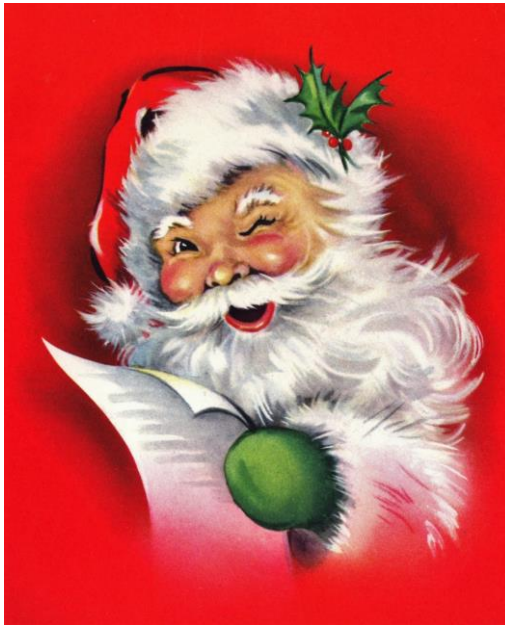
