To understand how digital cameras work

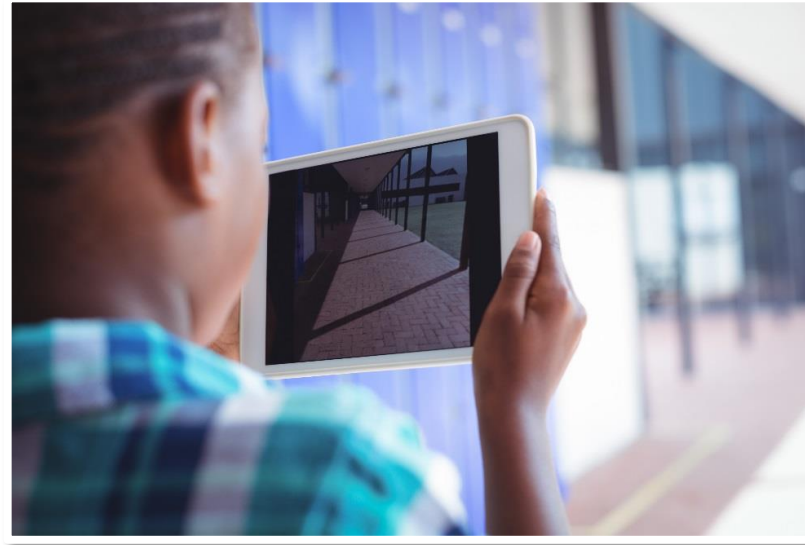
Let's learn

In the past, people could only take photographs with a camera, but now there are lots of devices that can take them.

Digital Camera



Let's learn: How does a digital camera work?

Inside each of the devices that take photographs, there is a computer chip containing millions of tiny **sensors** that measure the amount of light falling onto them and store this information as a number.

- The numbers from the sensors become the **pixels** (picture elements) of the image.
- Each pixel is made up of three numbers (a **colour value**), typically between 0 and 255, representing a colour as a combination of red, green and blue light (RGB). Up to 16 million different colours can be represented in this way.



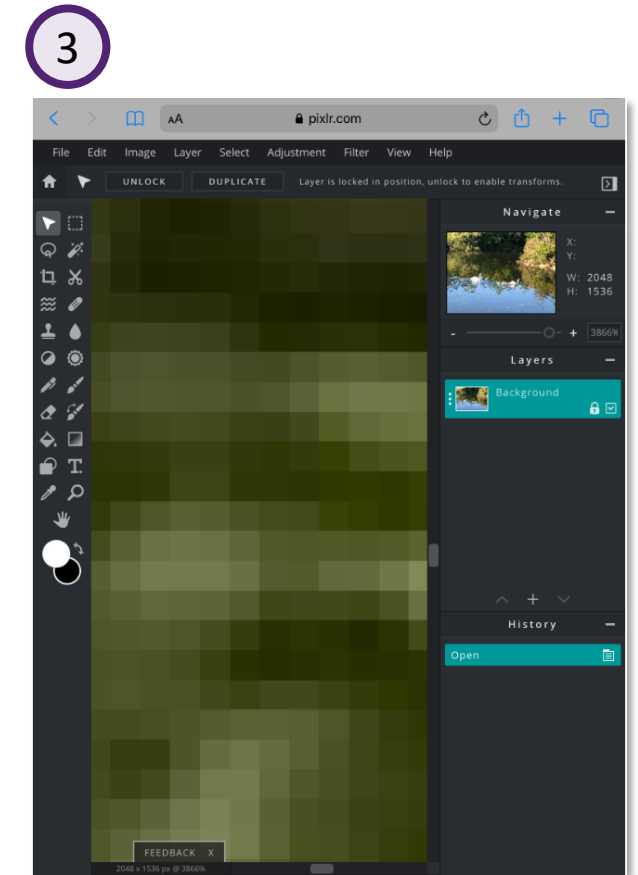
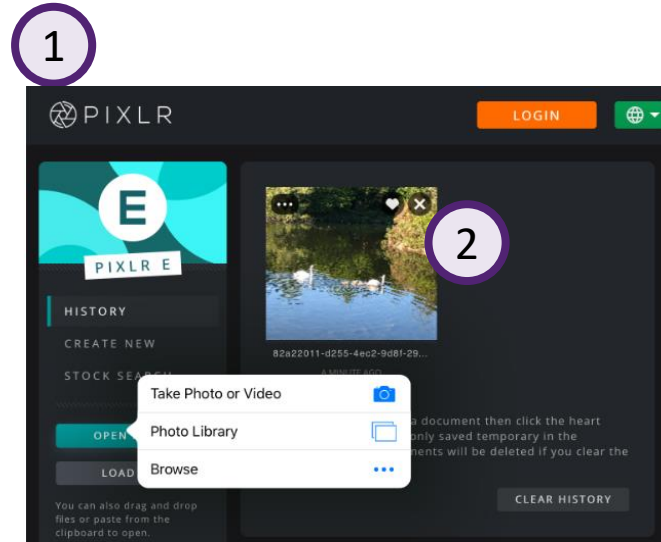

We can zoom in on photographs to see the individual pixels using a piece of software called Pixlr.

1. Open Pixlr (www.pixlr.com). Tap 'Open image' and then 'Photo Library'.
2. Find the photograph on your tablet and upload it.
3. Pull the photo outwards to zoom in to see the pixels.

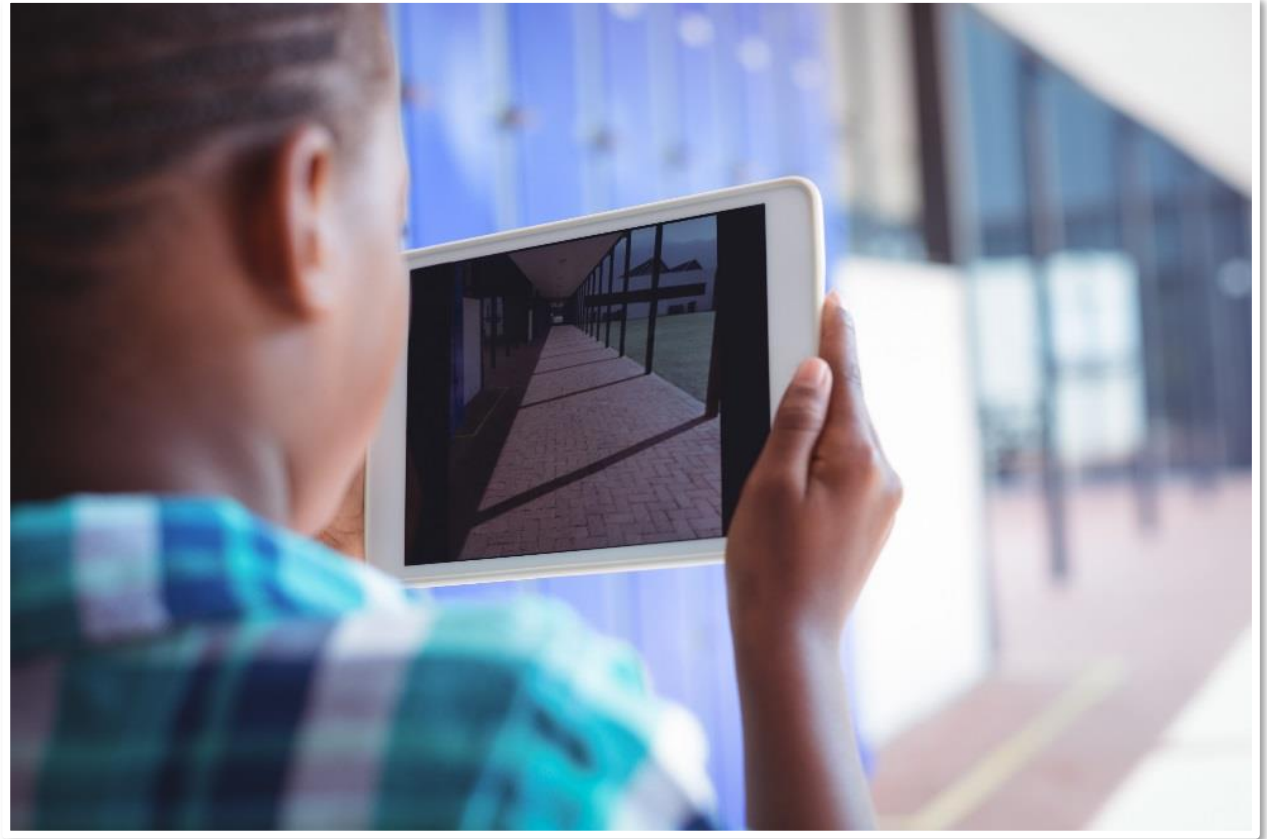

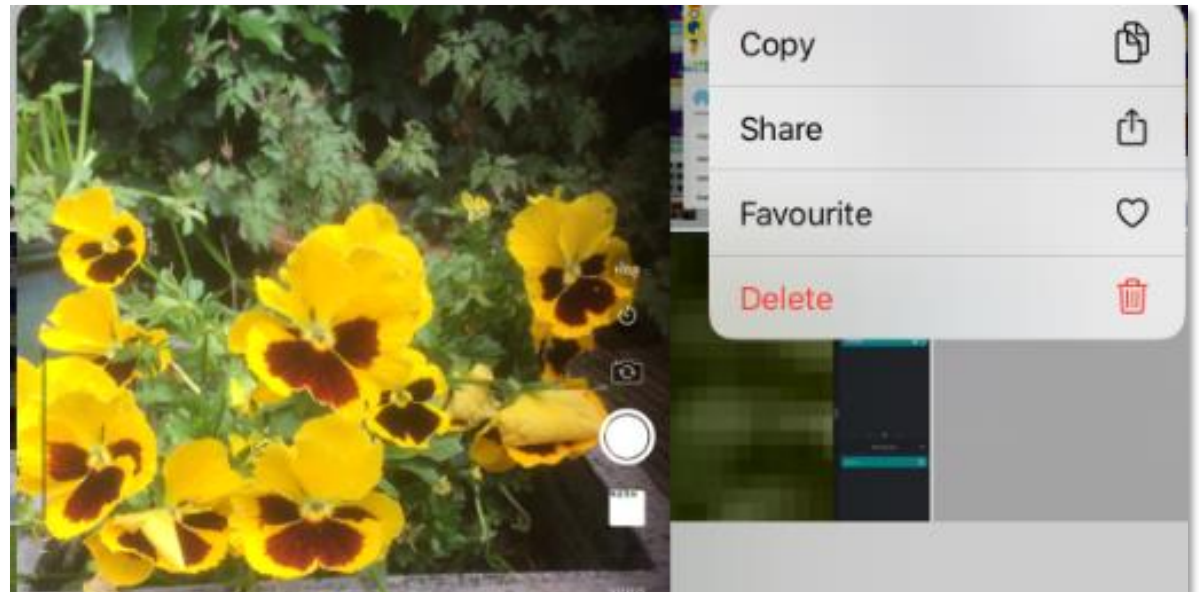
