Easter Symbols







The death of Jesus is represented by the cross shape on the top of a hot cross bun



Family and friends may give each other eggs on Easter Sunday. Eggs represent new life.



Chicks remind us that spring brings new life.



The Easter Bunny is a figure and symbol of Easter, depicted as a rabbit bringing Easter eggs.



Churches will sometimes make Easter gardens.
They tell us the story of Good Friday and Easter
Sunday.



The lamb remind us that Jesus was known as 'The lamb of God'.



The Pascal candle is a special candle lit in churches on Easter Sunday. Jesus is known as the light of the world and the Pascal candle is a sign of this.



Palm leaves remind us of Palm Sunday when people placed leaves on the ground as Jesus rode into Jerusalem.



An Easter bonnet is a fancy hat worn as a Christian head covering. It represents a tradition of wearing new clothes at Easter.
