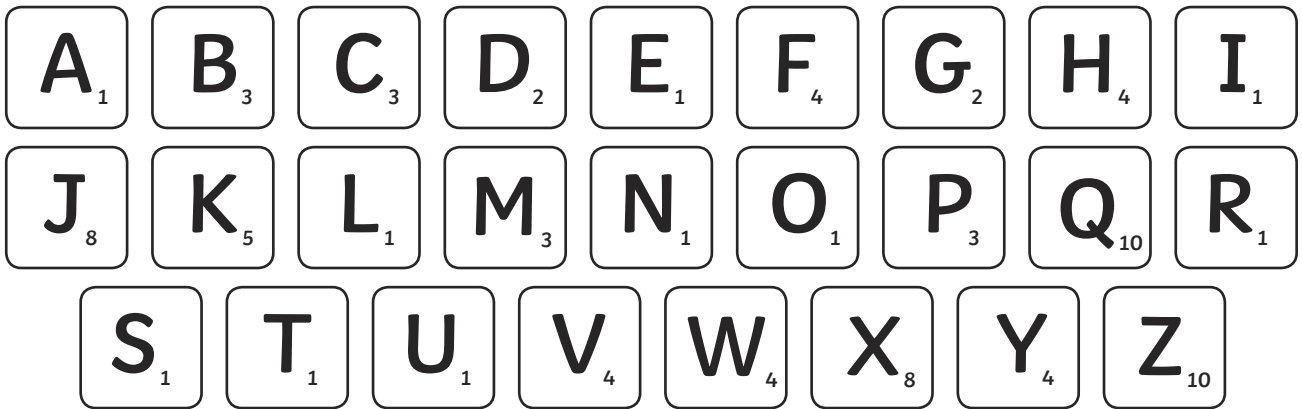


Letter Tiles Spellings

scorching	$1 + 3 + 1 + 1 + 3 + 4 + 1 + 1 + 2 =$	17
searing	$1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 2 =$	8
sizzling	$1 + 1 + 1 + 10 + 10 + 1 + 1 + 2 =$	27
blistering	$3 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 2 =$	13
sweltering	$1 + 4 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 2 =$	14
chilly	$3 + 4 + 1 + 1 + 1 + 4 =$	14
frozen	$4 + 1 + 1 + 10 + 1 + 1 =$	18
arctic	$1 + 1 + 3 + 1 + 1 + 3 =$	10
